DEAR MEMBERS & FRIENDS,

Gong Xi Fa Cai • Wan Shi Ru Yi! May all of your hearts' desires be fulfilled in every aspect of your aspirations in 2017!

For those who have yet to make your New Year Reunion Dinner reservation, please browse through the Club's Reunion Dinner Packages hosted at our Jade Foyer and Peach Garden Restaurant lined up for your festive celebrations and indulgences with families and friends. Exciting CNY's Prosperity Lo Hei promotions are available at the Vanda Terrace and Peach Garden Restaurant throughout the 15 days of celebrations.

2017 will be an exciting year at Orchid with a number of Club upgrading projects in the pipe-line to rejuvenate the aged facilities, and operations improvement to better serve our members' needs and expectation in today's context. One of such and much awaited projects to accentuate member's exclusivity is the installation of the vehicle IU identification & detection car parking barrier system at the current ingress and egress member's parking facility located at the basement which is targeted for completion in April/May 2017. A notification shall be sent to inform members to submit their vehicle IU numbers for input into the new parking system database by 15 March 2017.

A manual parking barrier system shall also be erected at the Club Main Entrance next to our Security Guard post 1 to manage and control vehicles access into the Club after operating hours to deter unauthorised vehicle access with the exception of Orchid Lodge hotel guests and those of our tenants.

Key Clubhouses and Driving Range restrooms' facilities shall also undergo upgrading to refresh its passé and dated design with emphasis on functionality, mechanical fresh air supply and circulation, ease of maintenance, energy and water conservation, and importantly a feel of freshness and comfort.

The most frequently patronised facility by our members and guests is none other than our Golf Registration and golf bag drop-off premises which were designed and built since 1996 or 20 years old to-date that would deservingly require a face-lift to revitalise both in terms of functionality and design outlook to better serve our members and guests in an air-conditioned enclosure. This project is ear-marked to commence after Lunar New Year 2017, and shall also include the back-of-house golf administration offices.

During the above mentioned upgrading projects, inevitably there will be some inconveniences which the management will do our utmost to minimise; with the provision of alternative service venues and facilities to ensure continuity of Club operations, and member services with little or no down time; and we seek your kind understanding and patience as we persevere with the endeavours to serve you better.

Our Golf Courses' bunker upgrading works are on schedule and I am happy to report that the bunkers' upgrading at Aranda Course has been completed, and the works are progressing well at Vanda Course which is scheduled for completion in January 2017. The upgraded bunkers shall be closely monitored to ensure the sub-soil drainage supplemented with connecting fish-bone drainage lines

will be able to sustain heavy downpour without water-log or ponding, sand erosion and compaction that would affect playability and its aesthetics.

We have stepped up on cultural practises, such as hollow, core and needle tinning on the fairways and greens to enhance aeration, absorption of nutrients, and drainage to improve turf health and growth. Preventive maintenance against cyclical diseases and fungal & algae infestations especially during the wet season are also in the works. Weeds management, fertilization programmes, tree-pruning, landscaping & horticultural works surrounding the golf courses, including the transplanting and addition of 9 numbers of coconut trees at Vanda Hole # One; and an addition of a yellow fern tree at Dendro Hole # One at its first ball landing area are some of the on-going works to improve the overall ambience, memorability, and as key markers to align your line of play.

On communications and engagement whilst enjoying your game at the courses, you would have recently noticed a Notice Board prominently installed at all 3 courses at Hole # One planter boxes presenting you with Club and golfing news, golf etiquettes, local rules, course maintenance programme and so forth to keep you in tuned with the what's new and what's happening at Orchid.

I would like to take this opportunity to specially remind all members to exercise care, patience and golf etiquettes as we indulge in our games to always repair divots, carry our sand bottles, and to pace our game to avoid slow play. And more importantly to always ensure that the flight/golfers ahead are clearly out of sight and range before executing your next shot. Lately, there have been a number of golfing incidents that were referred to the Club Disciplinary Committee as a result of executing a shot with the flight or golfers ahead still within sight and/or range that have led to "dangerous play" complaint; of which could have been easily avoided with a bit more exercise of discretion, patience, and graciousness to acknowledge one's misdoing in extending a sincere and timely apology. And in most instances, the potential complaint would have been mitigated without further escalation.

Always remember, a flying golf ball trajectory and speed can easily equate to a fired bullet that can cause severe physical injuries and fatality on impact. And the saying that "prevention is better than a cure" is most pertinent for all of us to keep at the forefront of our minds whilst on the golf courses.

As food for thought this season, I would like to share a relevant quote by Bill Gates that **"Treatment without prevention is simply unsustainable"** and, **"Sometimes it is more important to be gracious than to win"** by Dorothy Kilgallen.

Golf Course Maintenance Update

Completion of Bunker Upgrading at Aranda Course

As part of our ongoing effort to enhance the golf course facilities, the Club upgraded the bunkers at Aranda Course in August 2016 to provide better drainage system, minimise erosion and improve playability. The bunker upgrading process involved these stages:

- Sodding out bunker faces
- Removing existing bunker sand and bunker liner
- Checking and flushing of existing drainage
- Installation of additional drainage pipes to problem areas
- Overlaying of new sand trapper with 3M liners, evidently more porous, to the bunkers
(This increases the infiltration rate of water passing through the bunker profile, reducing the amount of sand being washed out and minimising sand contamination.)
- Re-infilling new bunker sand and re-turfing of the bunker faces with Zoysia Japonica

Meanwhile, the Club is working very closely with the contractor to ensure the upgraded Aranda bunkers are well maintained.

Bunker Upgrading at Vanda Course In Progress

To further improve your golfing experience, bunker upgrading at the Vanda Course is currently underway and is expected to complete by January 2017. The shape of each bunker will take on much of its former layout with exception to a few holes. For example, the front bunker at Vanda Hole # Two has been upgraded from a single bunker to a 3-tier bunker to elevate your golfing experience. You may refer to the below photos on its development. We will continue to provide you with updates on the progress of this enhancement project.

Golf Rules & Etiquette

For a fun golfing experience, keeping a good pace during golfing will help you enjoy the game better! Thus, here is a list of quick tips to help speed up your play!

Pace of Play

- Plan your shot while walking to your ball or while others are playing.
- Line up your putt when others are putting and be ready to play when it is your turn.
- Walk briskly between shots.
- Walk directly to your golf ball; don't follow others unless assisting in a search.
- If driving/riding a buggy, take several clubs with you to your ball so you won't have to walk back to the buggy.
- Don't step off yardage for every single golf shot. Develop an eye for distance.
- Be efficient with pre-shot routine.
- Minimise the number of practice swings.
- Play a provisional ball if you think the original might be lost outside a water hazard or out of bounds.
- Leave your clubs on the side of the putting green towards the next tee.
- Exit putting green promptly after holing out.
- Unless experienced, play the standard tees, not the championship tees.



Course Closure and Resumption of Play due to Inclement Weather

All players shall discontinue play immediately when the course suspension siren is sounded. Play shall resume only after the resume play siren is sounded. No player shall continue to play or resume play when play is under suspension. Players are required to remain in the shelters at all times.

When the course is declared open for play after suspension, players are permitted to continue with their game. However, if flights are unable to cross-over for their second 9 holes before 11.45 am, they have to stop after completion of their first 9 holes and make way for the subsequent sessions.

Players who have paid for a full 18-hole play in the morning and are unable to turn around by 11.45am may approach our Registration Staff in exchange of a 50% discount green fee voucher that will entitle you for a full 18-hole play on Monday or Tuesday (except Public Holidays).

Players whose tee-off were delayed by the weather in the morning and had registered and paid for 9-hole play only but wish to continue another 9 holes before 11.45 am, must register again and pay for the next 9 holes before proceeding with their course tickets to continue with play.
