## DEAR MEMBERS,

2017 has been a fulfilling year with much progress made to rejuvenate the Club's facilities and optimise the tenancy mix for the Club to stay relevant to meet the evolving needs of our members and guests. Henceforth, it gives me great pleasure to have the opportunity to share with you the various key projects that the Development & Tender Committee has been working on closely with the Club management for the past one year.

### Facilities Upgrading and Maintenance

The successful implementation of the Vehicle IU Identification Car Parking Barrier System at the members' carpark (basement of Social Clubhouse) in the second quarter, has successfully eliminated unauthorised vehicle parking and enhanced the exclusivity of our members' privileges.

The ageing restrooms at the Driving Range, Orchid Lodge Lobby, Aranda Lounge, Bunker Pool and Grand Ballroom & Jade Foyer were given an overhaul with core emphasis on functionality, water and energy conservation.

To date, the Club has completed most of its major Cyclical Asset replacement including the HT (high tension) & LT (low tension) switch gears, Transformers, Standby Generators, Passengers & Cargo Lifts, Over Ground (OG) Boxes serving all three Golf courses, Chillers & Cooling Towers, Air-Conditioner Fan Coil & Air Handling units, the Building Automation System (BAS) and etc.

We would like to thank all members and guests for your utmost co-operation, enabling the smooth running of the abovementioned projects.

### Optimising Tenancy Mix to Serve You Better

During the first quarter of 2017, we added a new tenant - PING@OCC, to offer custom club fitting services and PING golf equipment & accessories at the Driving Range. We also have a new F&B operator - Fatelicious Snack House, to operate Dendro Halfway House, as well as the "OCC Express" (mobile refreshment buggy) to provide light bites and refreshments for golfers' enjoyment at the courses. In May, we welcomed the Royal Palm restaurant, a halal certified F&B establishment serving International buffet dishes which adds to the cuisine options available in the Club for members' dining experiences.

In August, two underutilised tennis courts were converted into Futsal courts, a new sports recreational facility that promotes healthy bonding among members and their families and friends. In the same month, the outdoor children's playground near the Fun Pool underwent replacement of new play structure with interesting design

and equipment for members to spend quality bonding time with their young children when they are at the Club. Alternatively, members who prefer an indoor children's playground can visit Play Lah @ OCC, another new tenant who has joined OCC to provide a dinosaur concept indoor playground for children to create a memorable experience in the Club.

With our continuous efforts in tenancy optimisation, facility upgrading and maintenance, we hope to stay relevant to the changing lifestyle of members and guests; and make OCC a more vibrant Club with your strong support and patronage.

### New Enhancement Projects in 2018

Moving forward, there will be more enhancement projects in the pipeline such as refurbishment of Restrooms at Golf Clubhouse Level 1 & 2, Social Clubhouse Level 1 (next to Theatre) and the Fun Pool Changing Rooms. The Octagon and Driving Range Office will also undergo renovation to improve the ergonomics and interior outlook to enhance the service experience of our members and guests. More updates will be available soon, so do look out for our Club's announcement.

As we herald in the New Year with much preparation and anticipation, I would like to wish everyone a year full of fond memories, immeasurable blessings and success.

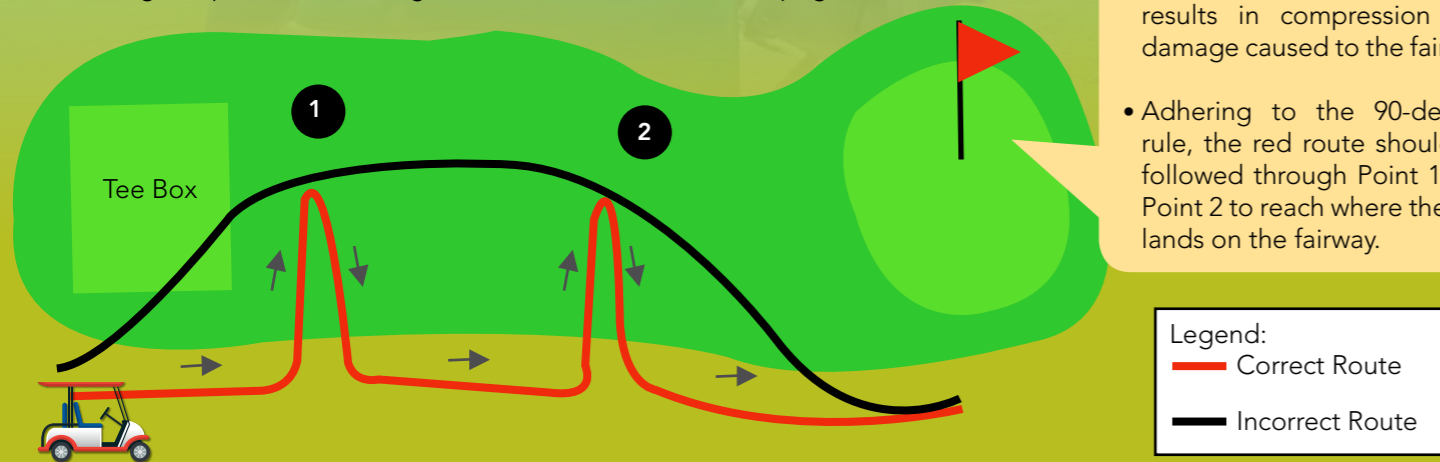


# THE 90-DEGREE RULE FOR BUGGIES

Do you know that you can help reduce tire marks on the grass turf today by doing a 90-degree turn to drive laterally across the fairway from the cart path to reach your golf ball?

You may have heard about the 90-degree rule in Golf, which is often introduced as a House Rule for golfers to observe and help maintain the golf courses in consistent good condition.

Most Golf Clubs in Singapore permit golfers to drive their buggies onto the fairway on dry days or when the course condition permits. However, by allowing this, the weight from the buggies can cause damage to the grass turf and flatten the grass blades, resulting in a poorer lie of the golf ball as the ball will not sit upright.



For those who have not been observing the 90-degree rule, do adopt this rule today and make golfing at the Club more enjoyable for golfers all year round. Happy Golfing!

- The black route is normally used when driving to where the golf ball lies. However, this results in compression and damage caused to the fairway.

- Adhering to the 90-degree rule, the red route should be followed through Point 1 and Point 2 to reach where the ball lands on the fairway.

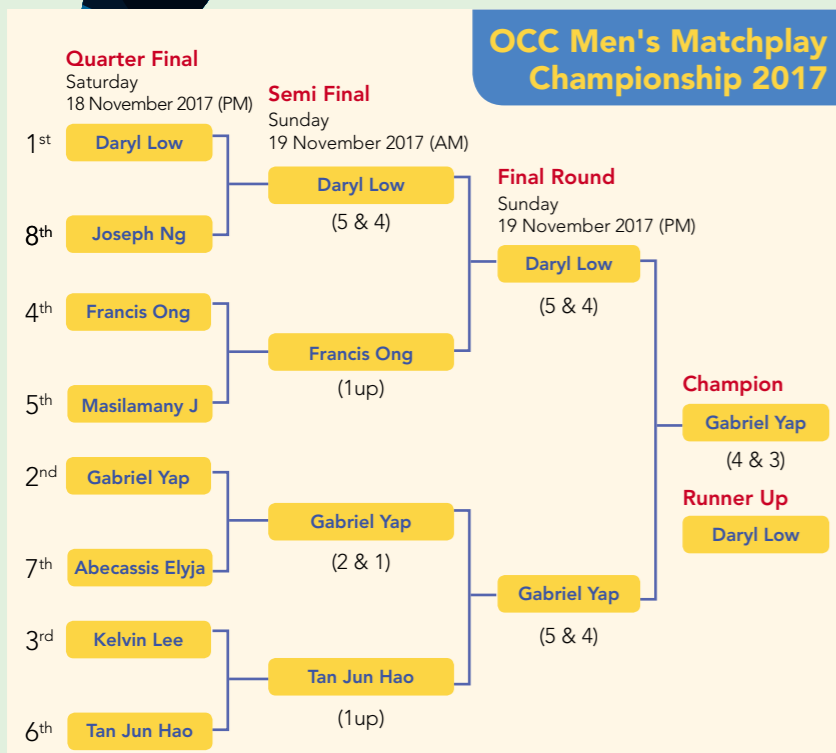

A misunderstanding of a proper spine tilt will lead to a bad set-up, reducing power and consistency. Hence, it is important to maintain the right spine tilt for better rotation and in turn, better performance.

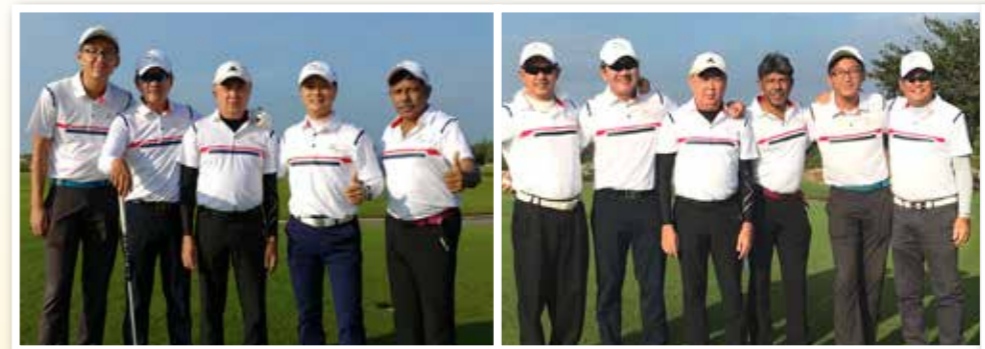

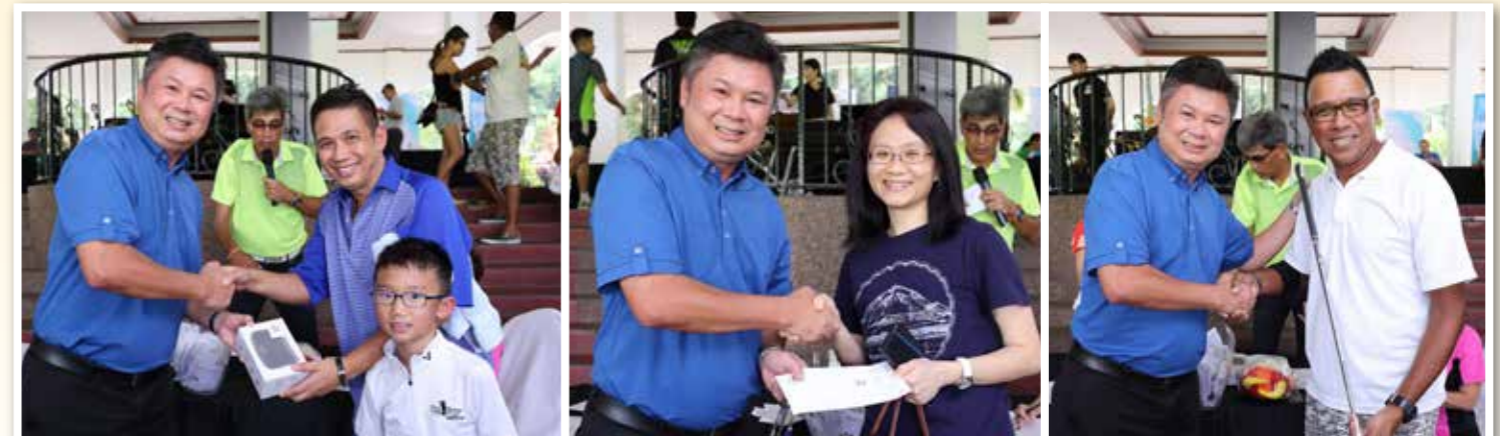

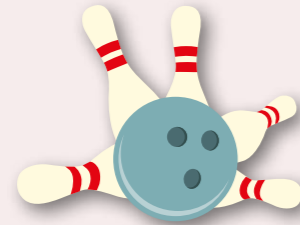

### 3. Goblet Squat

- Keep kettlebell close to your chest with your elbows lifted high
- Squat while driving your knees out (not caved in) and your chest lifted
- Drive your heels onto the floor while keeping your glutes engaged to return to standing position

### 2. Kettlebell Swing



- Begin with feet hip-width apart, keep your chest forward and your shoulders retracted
- Swing up the kettlebell using leg momentum and thrust your hips forward
- Engage your legs, hips, glutes and shoulders to power swing the kettlebell upward
- Keep your core tight throughout and ensure your back is not rounded

### 4. Kettlebell Row



- Begin with feet hip-width apart, holding the kettlebell on one hand
- Bend knees and hinge back at the hips. Torso to be almost parallel with the ground, without rounding the back
- Row the kettlebell up to the side of torso
- Ensure elbow is tucked close to your side and keep core engaged before lowering kettlebell back down
- Repeat on opposite arm in the next round
